Storyboard (Planning Sheet)	Has a well sketched storyboard that fully matches the comic. Teacher observed storyboard created prior to creation of comic strip. Full Page (Presentation)	A full page comic was pieced together with 8 panels with a layout showing extensive planning and thought.	A full page comic was pieced together with 8-7 panels with some neatness shown in layout.	¾ of a page was created with 8-6 panels pieced together, little effort shown in planning, and/or not neat.	Less than 6 panels pieced together, no effort shown in planning, and/or not neat.
